What are Elementary Summer Activity courses?

Summer Activity courses provide fun, challenging, and exciting learning opportunities, which capitalize on the different “intelligences” of children. These courses are offered to any elementary student (K-5) in the district. Instructors are certified teachers within the Bernards Township school system.

- All courses are held between 10:45 a.m. and 3:15 p.m. at Mount Prospect School, 111 Hansom Road, Basking Ridge.
- Each course runs Monday through Thursday, an hour a day, for two weeks. The dates for each session are as follows:

Session 1:

Week 1: Monday, July 9th – Thursday, July 12th

Week 2: Monday, July 16th – Thursday, July 19th

Session 2:

Week 1: Monday, July 23rd - Thursday, July 26th

Week 2: Monday, July 30th - Thursday, August 2nd

Tuition is \$135 per student for each eight-day course.

How to Register

- OPTION 1: You may register and pay for courses online. To make online payments go to www.bernardsboe.com, click on the parents tab, then click on the payments tab on the next page and then select the Summer Activities Program. You may pay by credit card or electronic check. There is a \$8.00 fee per transaction for online payment.
- OPTION 2: Complete the registration form provided in this brochure. Please send your registration form and separate checks for each course in an envelope marked “Summer Activities Program” to your child’s classroom teacher.
- You may select as many as four courses in Session 1 and four courses in Session 2 for a total of eight courses.
- It is important to select alternate(s) for each course, especially if you are interested in registering your child for a full day of scheduling (10:45-3:15). All first choices will be honored as long as the courses have openings.

- **Course Placement Decisions:** Courses are filled in the order the registration forms are received, either online or via hard copy. Once a course is full (number depends upon the course and the number of instructors), every effort will be made to place the student in his/her second alternative course selection. Please note that online payment does not guarantee enrollment. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis and courses will closed once they are filled; please send in your registration as soon as possible.
 - In order for a course to be held, a required minimum must be met. This varies per course, but generally 12 students per course are required. Some courses are limited to a maximum number of students, and that will be noted in the course description. The Summer Activities Program strives to maintain a ratio of 10-15 students per teacher.
 - Please use your child's current grade when registering for classes; a student now in kindergarten may enroll in a kindergarten class.
 - Confirmations will be sent home via e-mail beginning in May. Please do not call the office for activity program confirmations.
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Payment

- Tuition is \$135 per student for each eight-day course.
 - Checks should be made payable to the **"Bernards Township Board of Education"**.
 - **PLEASE ISSUE A SEPARATE CHECK FOR EACH COURSE IN WHICH YOUR CHILD WOULD LIKE TO ENROLL.**

- A lunch break will be held 12:45-1:15 for students. If your child will be attending the program during this time, please send your child with a lunch/snack. No lunch will be served.
- Students should behave in an appropriate manner. School rules of conduct apply to summer programs. Any student who violates the rules may be removed from the program. Please discuss this with your child.
- You may drop off your child 10 minutes prior to their first class. Dropping-off earlier than that may not ensure supervision while they wait for their class to begin. Please be considerate of our staff and pick up your child promptly at their dismissal time. If late pickups occur more than twice, the student will not be allowed to continue in the program. No refund will be given for missed classes.

- Please be aware that during the After School Activities Program there will be NO NURSE IN THE SCHOOL BUILDING.

Session 1

S1 - 1 - WE - World Explorers!

Get ready to travel around the world! In this course we will visit new and exciting places without ever needing a suitcase! Throughout the course, we will explore different cities, states and countries. Together we will go on adventures to learn about the cultures, traditions, sites and foods of each location. We will create a journal of our journeys as we go along to remember our exciting discoveries! Students will be invited to share about a favorite place they have traveled to and bring in a special treasure or keepsake. Buckle up and enjoy the ride!

Grades: K, 1, 2, 3

S1 - 2- US - Under the Sea

In this class, we will meet a new species of ocean animal each day. Students will learn about how the animal lives, where they live, what they eat, and many other interesting facts, including why they may or may not be endangered. Afterwards, students will have the opportunity to create a version of the ocean animal of the day, either drawing them, coloring them, or writing a story about them.

S1 - 3- SWD - Step Into the World of DROON!

Calling all Secrets of Droon fans!!!! Did you ever want to create a spell for Galen Longbeard or make a map of Droon? Maybe design a dress for Princess Keeah or plan a trap for Lord Sparr? Now's your chance! Join us for readings from the Secrets of Droon series and create your own Secrets of Droon Guide Book. We will also focus on basic story elements, such as characterization, setting, and problem/solution. So walk down the rainbow-colored staircase and join us for a magical journal through Droon!

S1 - 4 - MS - Magicians School

Wow your parents and amaze your brothers, sisters, relatives, and friends with a variety of magic tricks! Students will learn a variety of magic tricks utilizing cards, coins, optical illusions, and sleights of the hand. Students will also gain experience in dramatic presentation, public speaking, and oral language as well. Come join the fun and mystery!

Grades: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

S1 - 5 - DP - Digital Photography

Do you love taking pictures? Come join our Digital Photography class! This course focuses on children gaining skills in creating well composed photographs. Using their own cameras, students will be instructed on ways to shoot for specific effects and multiple techniques that produce better photos. We will focus on automatic, portrait, landscape, macro, and sport/action modes. Children will create a presentation to showcase the different techniques and effects learned. Along with their own camera, please send your child to class with the USB cable to connect the camera to the computer. We will upload photos and edit them.

S1 - 6 - HP - Harry Potter and Crafts

Attention all witches, wizards, and muggles! Are you ready to revisit your favorite scenes from the books and movies? We will read or watch a clip and then create items and keepsakes to help us keep the fun from Harry Potter alive in our hearts. Come join the magical world of Harry Potter!

S1 - 7 - ICD - I Can Draw!

Anyone can be an artist! Come join the fun and create amazing artwork in your sketch pad provided! Learn how simple shapes lead the way to awesome characters, animals, castles, and more!! Don't be left out of the fun!

S1 - 8 - CC - Chess Club

What move will your pawn make? Join the Bernards Township Chess Club to decide! Beginning students will be introduced to the basic rules and strategies of chess and develop their problem solving skills. Intermediate and advanced players will explore the use of expert strategies. Students will be grouped based on their level of playing and will have an opportunity to move into a more advanced group if necessary. Please indicate your child's level of playing on the registration form. A voluntary chess tournament will culminate this course

Grades: K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

S1 - 9 - FC - Fit Club

Do you love running around, playing tag games with friends, being active, jump roping, and going on walks? Learn new jump rope games, dances and other fun ways to stay fit and healthy. We will do aerobic activities inside and walk/jog outside when the weather permits. Bring your sneakers and wear clothing comfortable for physical activity. We will end with a dance party.

S1 - 10 - CB - Crafting with Beads

In this class, students will use beads, string, wire, and other materials, to create wonderful crafts, including jewelry, keychains, mobiles, and windchimes.

S1 - 11 - LC - The Lego Challenge

Calling all creative kids! Each class will begin with a story or scenario that will be presented to the class. Students will be given a challenge after each lesson and create their own design using their own interpretation of what they learned. Example: Listen to the story of "The 3 Little Pigs" ...create a structure that would keep the pigs safe! Ready, Set, Go!

Grades: 2, 3, 4, 5

S1 - 12 - CF - Calling all Foodies

Do you love to create yummy treats or impress your family with delicious meals? If so, you have found the right place! Calling all Foodies will explore all things scrumptious and satisfying. Together we will discover a variety of cuisines and share some of our favorite foods and recipes. We will also learn about basic food groups and healthy nutrition for kids! Students will be asked to bring in and share a favorite family recipe. Each student will take home a Foodies Recipe Book comprised of all our recipes. Let's see what's cooking!

Please note: this course will not be creating or serving any food products.

S1 - 13 - SA - STEAM Arcade

Use your imagination to engineer cardboard arcade games that we will be able to play! Inspired by the ingenuity of Cane's Arcade we will deconstruct classic games, such as the crane game and skee ball, and figure out how to recreate them in a functional way using cardboard, masking tape, scissors and recycled objects.

S1 - 14 - O - Overtime

This mini unit allows students of all ability levels to come and work together in different physical education games and challenges. Team building, strategy, sportsmanship, and fun are all the main components of this mini unit. Students will be encouraged to try different games and activities to have fun. If fun and fitness are what you're looking for then the Overtime mini unit is just for you!

S1 - 15 - BB - Beads and more Beads

Let's be creative with beads. We will be using Perler beads and other types of beads to create beautiful and interesting keepsakes. Some ideas are keychains, bookmarks and magnetic fun crafts. Come join the fun!

S1 - 16 - AO - Amazing Origami

Do you like art and creating unique projects with paper? In this course, you will make all kinds of amazing creatures and objects through the art of Japanese paper folding. While learning folding techniques, students will also be introduced to mathematical terms in this hands-on experience. Some projects will be even be math related! All levels and abilities welcome as creations can be differentiated upon the students' abilities.

S1 - 17 - PM - Pillow Making

Making pillows is easier than you think! Come join the fun learning a few simple steps using fleece and fabric. Choose your shape, your style and create! Not only will we be making pillows, we will also be making a stuffed animal pillow. I can't wait to see all of your unique creations!

Note: You will need fabric scissors for this course.

S1 - 18 - GN - Game Night!

Do you love to play board games at family game nights? Then this mini unit is for you! Come join me for a mini-unit where we will learn to play different board games! Board games entertain and bring people together through competitive and cooperative game play. Your child will learn to play a variety of different board games over the two weeks. Playing board games also allows for the practice of essential cognitive skills, like problem solving.

S1 - 27 - CB - Crimebusters!

Do you enjoy solving mysteries? Together we will analyze fingerprints and water samples, learn to read a star chart, and use chromatography. We will practice detective science in order to rescue a fellow scientist! Please join us!

S1 - 19 - SC - STEM Club

Do you like to build and explore? Come join us for Science, Technology, Engineer and Math Club. Develop your creativity, critical thinking, collaboration skills and confidence while working in teams as well as individually. Some activities include: build a car with k'nex, shoebox marble run, Save Fred, newspaper tower, code.org, tissue box catapult, and more!

S1 - 20 - PP - The Presidential Plunge!

S1 - 22 - T - Trivia

This mini unit allows students of all ages to get tested in all types of factual information. Topics will be random but this team comradery based activity will include topics such as, Disney, Sports, History, Math, Science, Animals, and pretty much anything you can think of. If you like to learn new facts and try and work together with your peers in solving these questions then Trivia is perfect for you!

S1 - 23 - LB - Lego Building

This building club will offer the children an opportunity to explore their creativity and learn about architecture, engineering and design using Legos. Each class children are given an age appropriate building challenge that requires them to problem solve. They will plan, build, test and evaluate using set criteria. Through free building sessions and themed activities and challenges, children will improve their critical thinking skills, fine motor abilities and develop teamwork and communication skills they can use in daily life.

S1 - 24 - BF - Bird Feeders

Are you looking for a fun time making homemade bird feeders? It's amazing what you can make using everyday items around the house. We will be creating all types of bird feeders. We will using pinecones, cookie cutters, popsicle sticks and other household items. How many birds do you think you will attract to your backyard with the bird feeders you are going to make?

S1 - 25 - ASW - STEAM Ancient Science Workshop

Students will learn about famous inventions, from ancient times as well as the culture of those civilizations. Students will time travel around the world and explore scientific activities from ancient places such as China, Egypt, Rome, Greece and South America to name a few! Students will become archaeologists while investigating the Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math of ancient societies.

S1 - 26 - ER - Escape Room

Clue mixed with riddles. Be "locked" in a classroom where you need to solve riddles to gain clues. Once you solve the riddle, you will be sent to another clue that will need to be solved. S2 - 3 - MT - Musical Theater

Musical Theater is for all students who enjoy acting, singing and/or dancing or even the behind-the-scenes work of music theater such as choreographing, stage management, directing and etc. In this course, we will work mainly on the performance side of theater and sing, act and even do a little dancing. Some more experienced students may even take on the role of the director or choreographer. If you have participated in this class before, we will be doing scenes and songs from a new musical. We will end our class with an "open rehearsal/short performance" to show our families what we have been learning!

Join Young Scientists for fun and educational science experiments and activities! Do you love the Magic School Bus and experimenting with different materials? Well, Young Scientists is perfect for you! These experiments include slime, lava lamps, and more! Get your science juices flowing!

S2 - 5 - SHR - Super Heroes to the Rescue

Calling all Avengers. Have you ever wanted to join the superheroes? Well now is your chance. Get ready to fight bad guys and discover the secret to being a successful superhero. We will create super hero gear, perform reader's theatre from the comics, solve math riddles, engage in puzzles that challenge our brains, and perform exercises to get our bodies ready. This course will actively engage our minds and bodies to become the best superhero possible.

Grades: K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

S2 - 6 - SF - Slime Factory

Got Slime? Come join us and mix up your own gooey creations in the Slime Factory. In this mini-unit we will be using the fundamentals of science and our creativity to produce slime of all types. From classic slime to "foam" slime, glitter slime to glow slime - there's no end to our slime-tastic concoctions. Already a slime making expert? Come share your favorite slime recipes with others in the Slime Factory. So join today, and be a part of the slime making movement.

Grades: 2, 3, 4, 5

S2 - 7 - YMM - Yoga, Mindfulness, and Meditation for Kids

In this course, students will explore the power of being calm, reflective, and mindful within the business of our daily lives. I will introduce the students to calming strategies, mindfulness techniques, and skills needed to make healthy choices in the future. Students will spend a large portion of time learning and perfecting yoga poses and finding their balance! Some activities will include constructing models li out of various materials and making origami characters like Yoda and Darth Vader. Students will do Star Wars coding for the technology portion of this STEAM mini-unit. We will investigate coordinate graphs and engage in Star Wars math activities.
